REPORT ON THE ONE DAY NATIONAL LEVEL WEBINAR ON "MAHENDRANATH DUTTA MEMORIAL LECTURE" ORGANIZED BY DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICS, SURI VIDYASAGAR COLLEGE

A one-day national level webinar on 5th "Mahendranath Dutta Memorial Lecture" organized by Department of Mathematics, Suri Vidyasagar College, was held on <u>15.07.2021</u> from 11:00 a.m. onwards at Google meet. The resource persons were Prof. Arijit Ghoshal, Head of the Department of Mathematics, The University of Burdwan and Dr. Gaurav Varshney, Department of Mathematics, S.B.S.Govt. P.G. College (affiliated to Kumaon University Nainital) Rudrapur, Uttarakhand. The numbers of attendees were about 229 including faculty members, Non-teaching Staff and students.

The Topic of lectures was –

- 1. Prof. Arijit Ghoshal AN INTRODUCTION TO NEWTONIAN MECHANICS
- 2. Dr. Gaurav Varshney MATHEMATICAL MODELING OF BLOOD FLOW IN ARTEIAL SYSTEM

Duration of the seminar- 11:00 a.m. to 01:00 p.m.

The presenter, Dr. Sujoy Das, Assistant Professor& Head, Department of Mathematics talked about "Mahendranath Dutta Memorial Lecture". He also introduced the resource persons of the webinar. Welcome address was delivered by the Principal Dr. Tapan Kumar Parichha. The principal presided over the webinar. Dr. Ramprosad Saha, Assistant Professor of Mathematics, Suri Vidyasagar College delivered the keynote address in which he emphasized the brief history on Mahendranath Dutta. The first lecture was delivered by Prof. Arijit Ghoshal, Professor and Head, Department of Mathematics, The University of Burdwan. He laid the foundation of the topic "AN INTRODUCTION TO NEWTONIAN MECHANICS" by defining the various terms in context, like; distance, time, and mass etc. He also describes (i) Law of inertia: A body remains at rest or in uniform motion unless acted upon by a force. (ii) Equation of motion: A body acted upon by a force moves in such a manner that the time rate of change of momentum equals the force. He talked about the basics of Newtonian Mechanics such as Newton's Laws of Motion, Newtonian Kinematics, mechanics of a single particle, motion with a constant force, harmonic oscillator, charged particle in a magnetic field, momentum and angular momentum, Work, energy and potential forces, center of mass, reduced mass, one-dimensional conservative motions, systems with constraints and special co-ordinates, motion in a central field.

The next speech was delivered by Dr. Gaurav Varshney, Assistant Professor, Department of Mathematics, S.B.S. Govt. P.G. College (affiliated to Kumaon University Nainital) Rudrapur, Uttarakhand. He laid the foundation of the topic "MATHEMATICAL MODELING OF BLOOD FLOW IN ARTEIAL SYSTEM" by defining the various terms in context, like; micropolar fluids, nonsymmetric stress tensor, Newtonian fluidetc. He also describes micropolar fluids, spin inertia, blood vessel. He also explainedMathematical model for the blood flow through an artery having mild stenosis, magnetic field of uniform strength of blood flow. Governing equations are explained using numerical finite difference method. The effects of various flow parameters on the Micropolar fluid model of blood flow are analyzed graphically. An important conclusion which is drawn from the solution of the present problem is that flow characteristic of blood is influenced by the presence of stenosis and externally applied magnetic field. Interaction session between the participants and the resource persons took place after the deliberation was over. The participants enthusiastically asked questions and the resource persons answered with equal vigor. Finally, the vote of thanks was delivered by Prof. Shebhendu Ghosh, Associate Professor of Mathematics, Suri Vidyasagar College. The seminar officially came to an end at around 02:00 p.m.



### Report on the Seminar on NAD


A one-day seminar-cum-workshop on National Academic Depository was held on 21st May, 2022 at Suri Vidyasagar College. The attendance was about 120 student and faculty members and non -teaching staff. The Principal, Dr. Tapan Kumar Parichha, pointed up the relevance of the seminar in this age of technology. He said that the goal of NAD is not only to impart accessibility power to the students but to save them from the hurdles of proving their bona fide candidature. The chief speaker, Dr. Pradip Kumar Roy, Deputy Controller of Examinations and Nodal Officer, NAD, The University of Burdwan, started his presentation by giving us a background idea about the project. He said that the government wants to go paperless to save the environment. NAD also saves time. UGC runs this project and BU website holds all NAD details, including the link for the official NAD website. DigiLocker is an inclusive depository system that safeguards students from losing important documents. Now students need not wait for convocation to get their certificates. Dr. Roy also offered hands-on training to students on how to search and download their academic credentials. A replica of a degree certificate was shown to the audience. He added that DigiLocker would contain all government-issued certificates in one place in the near future. It is now available as an app and has its own web-based version too. Students need to get their Aadhaar ID linked with mobile number to sign up. DigiLocker documents are on a par with the original ones. University certificates are to be found under the category of 'Education'. Candidates should keep this in mind that registration and roll number are needed for accessing certificates. NAD is not only useful for the regular students, but for those who take a break in between or want to change university following the multi-exit system. SWAYAM, an e-learning platform, offers more choices in this regard. Students can score 20-40 percent of their credits from SWAYAM. Teachers can also pursue courses on SWAYAM. It is hoped that digitalisation will make courses more dynamic. For now, only certificates, not mark-sheets, are available on DigiLocker. Google Meet option can be availed of and nad@burunive.ac.in is the official NAD mail address of the university. DigiLocker offers 2 GB of storage completely free of charge. Dr. Roy then assured the students that mother copies or hard copies would also be distributed along with the downloadable documents.

Question-answer session opened after the presentation followed by a brief discussion by Dr. Jagabandhu Nandi who said a few words about the vision of the government to make syllabi, entrance tests and grading system uniform throughout the country so that students can enjoy more flexibility. Finally, the Vote of Thanks was delivered by Prof. Kalan Mal, the current TCS of the college.


